



MOU Between the
MiraCosta Community College District and
MiraCosta Community College District – Faculty Assembly

This agreement extends MOU 18-01 and modifies the terms of section C.11.0 of the Faculty Assembly 2018-2021 contract to allow for the specific project identified below:

- 1) The District began conducting ongoing co-curricular academic and career-related activities and events relevant to each Academic and Career Pathway (ACP) in fall 2018. Faculty were appointed to serve as ACP faculty leaders during the 2018-2019 academic year. There is a need to continue this work during the 2019-2020 academic year.
- 2) The Academic Senate President, in consultation with the appropriate department chair and dean, shall appoint six (6) instructional faculty and two (2) counseling faculty to serve as ACP faculty leaders.
- 3) Classroom Faculty: ACP instructional faculty leaders shall undertake the following responsibilities:
 - a. Engage faculty, staff, and students in design of ACP activities and student support framework;
 - b. Coordinate and participate in ACP activities;
 - c. Lead ACP team members in collaboration and planning meetings;
 - d. Collaborate with other ACP leads; and
 - e. Participate in Guided Pathways coordinating group or workgroup meetings.
- 4) Non-classroom Faculty: ACP counseling faculty leadership shall undertake the following responsibilities:
 - a. Engage counseling colleagues in the implementation and design of ACP activities;
 - b. Coordinate and participate in ACP activities;
 - c. Lead ACP team members in collaboration and planning meetings;
 - d. Collaborate with other ACP leads; and
 - e. Participate in Guided Pathways coordinating group or workgroup meetings.
- 5) Each ACP faculty leader shall be provided with 0.2 FTE (3 LHE) reassigned time per semester in support of ACP leadership responsibilities.
- 6) Support for summer responsibilities: Each ACP faculty leader shall be compensated at the applicable non-contractual, non-teaching hourly rate for participation in planning meetings during the summer months, not to exceed fifteen (15) hours for meeting participation and preparation.

This agreement will become effective upon approval. It shall expire on June 30, 2020.
